



**One Year, Chronological  
Bible Reading Schedule,**

*With Wisdom for Each Day from Job and Proverbs*

## **Introduction**

As the Christian should store up the word of God in his heart, letting it be the lamp which guides his every step, the daily reading of the Scriptures is paramount to that success. This one-year Bible reading schedule takes the reader through the Bible in a chronological order. While it's not possible to align every passage or chapter in a chronological fashion, this schedule strives to make it as easy-as-possible to see the events as they occur along the Bible timeline. Some events read in the Scriptures are naturally more accurate than others, often identifying clear time markers from Bible history. Also, there are some parts of Scripture which occur simultaneously. Since the reader cannot read two things at the same time, this schedule aligns some of those simultaneous events contemporary with each other in the daily reading. An example is Daniel, Ezra, and Nehemiah, which are arranged as “close as possible”, given the overlap between king Cyrus and regent Darius — so the reader can get a sense of when those events occurred in relation to one another.

## **Daily Passages**

The books of the Bible are laid out for daily reading. The books of Job and Proverbs are not included in the chronological line of reading. However, each day includes a small section from the books of Job and Proverbs. This approach gives the reader an opportunity to meditate on the small sections of great Bible Wisdom throughout their day. In this way, Job and Proverbs are not read quickly in a few days, but throughout the year, each day providing the reader with a “line upon line” approach to the many precious nuggets of Wisdom found in the text.

### **Wisdom from Job**

The daily reading from the Book of Job consists of several verses, ensuring when a sentence spans several verses, the whole sentence is read on that day. Completing one or more sentences each day helps give context to the reading. The reading of Job is in a linear fashion, as most of the book of Job is an on-going conversation between Job and others, with some narration.

### **Wisdom from Proverbs**

The daily reading from the Book of Proverbs is arranged by subject. The subject arrangement follows the decade-long work done by Donald Orthner and his family in their book *Wellsprings of Life*, 1989, Bob Jones University Press. Following this pattern, each day's section consists of one or more verses which teach a key topic. In many verses, more than one subject is taught. Hence, there will be times when the reader will read a verse more than once throughout the schedule. Once this schedule is completed, the reader will have read through the whole Book of Proverbs at least one time. Some days will have a few verses and some days will have more, depending on the subject at hand. When a large number of verses contribute to a certain topic, those are split among two or more days for convenience. The order of the references is not necessarily linear.

### **Daily Arrangement**

Each day's stanza shows the day number (i.e., 1, 23, 59), the main daily passage (chronological reading section), and the Wisdom from Job on the first row. The second row shows the main subject and references from the Wisdom of Proverbs.

## Bonus Reading
